TO CONSIDER THE MINUTES/ RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE 49th MEETING OF THE BOARD OF STUDIES HELD ON 15.12.2020 AT 3:00 PM.

The Members of the Academic Council considered in detail the **recommendations / minutes** along with **AGENDA** of the Board of Studies held on 15.12.2020 at 3.00 PM and **approved** as under as :-

- 1) CREATION OF "EMERGENCY MEDICINE DEPARTMENT" AT SANTOSH MEDICAL COLLEGE AND HOSPITAL, GHAZIABAD,**

NCR DELHI ACCORDING TO NATIONAL MEDICAL COMMISSION (NMC)'S REGULATIONS VIDE NOTIFICATION NO.NMC/MCI 35(1)98-MED.(ii)123627 DATED 28-10-2020.

The members of the Academic Council considered the **recommendations / minutes** of the Board of Studies to create "**EMERGENCY MEDICINE DEPARTMENT**" at Santosh Medical College and Hospital, Ghaziabad, NCR Delhi and **recommended/approved** as under: -

To create Emergency Medicine Department at SANTOSH MEDICAL COLLEGE, GHAZIABAD, NCR DELHI, according to the norms of the NMC vide their Gazette Notification dated 28-10-2020 as under, initially for increase of M.B.B.S seats from 100 to 150 for the year 2021-22 onwards for **LOP (1st Batch) and 1st Renewal (2nd Batch)**.

The basic qualifications for faculty members in the department of Emergency Medicine are as under besides the minimum teaching experience and research publications from a recognized Medical institution/ Medical College:-

The above basic qualifications are valid for **ten years** i.e., upto 08-06-2027 as above Regulations amended upto 8th June 2017 according to above Regulation's Note is as under:-

"The academic qualification as shown above will be the academic qualification required for teaching faculty post for a period of 10 years w.e.f date of Notification. It is reiterated that only the academic qualification of MD (Emergency Medicine) will be the required academic qualification for appointment to the post of teaching faculty after the expiry of the period of 10 years from the date of Notification".

As per NMC Gazette Notification dated 28-10-2020 for increase of M.B.B.S. seats from 100 to that of 150, the requirement of faculty and Senior Residents for **LOP(1st batch) and 1st Renewal (2nd batch)** are as under:

It was also recommended by BOS that initially for LOP(1st Batch) and 1st Renewal (2nd Batch) the requirement is one Associate Professor and one Asst. Professor from any basic qualifications i.e., M.D.(General Medicine)/M.S.(Gen.Surgery)/M.D.(Resp.Medi.)/M.D.(Anaesthesia)/M. S.(Orthopaedics)besides experience as required. Six Senior Residents from Emergency Medicine one each from Medicine, Surgery, Paediatrics, OBG, Orthopaedics and Anaesthesia.

2) TO START A VALUE-ADDED CERTIFICATE COURSE ON "ROLE & RESPONSIBILITY OF AN INDIAN MEDICAL GRADUATE IN CONNECTING CRIME WITH CRIMINAL" IN THE DEPARTMENT OF FORENSIC MEDICINE, SANTOSH MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL, GHAZIABAD, NCR DELHI—REVISED

The members of the Academic Council considered the **recommendations / minutes** of the Board of Studies for some **changes** to start a value-added certificate course in **"Role & Responsibility of An Indian Medical Graduate in Connecting Crime with Criminal"** in the **Department of Forensic Medicine** and **recommended/approved** as under: -

"1. Name of the Course

"Role & Responsibility of An Indian Medical Graduate in Connecting Crime with Criminal"

2. Duration of the Course

16 hours (02-04) pm for 8 Saturdays

3. Eligibility Criteria

M.B.B.S 2nd year onwards

4. No. of Students: Upto 30 per Batch

5. Course Fee: Rs.500 per student

6. Course Director: Navin Kumar M.Varma, Prof & HOD of Forensic Medicine.

7. Course Methodology & Syllabus

The main objective of the program is to help the Indian Medical Graduates to understand their responsibility and role in connecting a crime with the criminal while handling a medico legal case in their day to day practice. In order to do that, an IMG need to understand their extended role, not only in examination and filing of a medico legal report, but to depose a case as expert witness in the court of law as well. Most of the time, when an IMG starts working either as Medical Officer or as an emergency medicine resident, they need to face day to day MLC works and they are unable to imply the practical aspect of Forensic Medicine independently, starting from MLC report making to Post Mortem examination, till deposing a case as expert witness. This workshop will give them the scope and knowledge of expertly handling a medico legal case and how to formulate an expert opinion and how to depose a case as expert witness in the court of law. The duty of a doctor starts right from emergency and it continues as autopsy surgeon if patient doesn't survive. So, it is very important to understand the responsibility of IMG as an expert witness for the administration of justice."
